## TSA ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS TAKEN IN 2012

Last week, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) issued its [annual summary](#) for calendar year 2012 of all enforcement actions taken by TSA under the authority granted in the implementing recommendations of the 9/11 Commission Act of 2007 for violations of surface transportation requirements and requirements related to transportation worker identification credentials (TWIC). (49 U.S.C. § 114(v)). Under delegated authority from the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, TSA may impose civil penalties of up to \$10,000 per violation.

In [2012](#), TSA took 27 enforcement actions against railroads, transit authorities, and trucking companies. Penalties ranged from warning notices and letters of correction to fines of up to \$50,000.
